This photograph was taken in 1969 and features retired Texas Ranger M. T. Gonzaullas standing beside a wax figure of himself at the Southwestern Historical Wax Museum at the State Fair Park in Dallas, Texas. Ranger Gonzaullas was known as "El Lobo Solo" (The Lone Wolf) because he often pursued bootleggers, gamblers, and drug runners on his own. In 1935, Gonzaullas served as the Superintendent of the DPS Bureau of Intelligence and created a crime laboratory second only to the FBI.
